

STRIVING FOR JESUS

Unless the Lord builds the house, those who build it labor in vain. Unless the Lord watches over the city, the watchman stays awake in vain. Psalm 127:1

We have worked hard these last five years. Steeped in prayer and filled with hope, we have toiled and labored for God's kingdom as the people of Joy Mission Church.
