DISCIPLESHIP CORNER -**CHOSEN**

Jesus says to His disciples,

"You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide, so that whatever you ask the Father in my name, he may give it to you." (John 15:16)

Jesus has chosen you. You had no say about it, no means of protest, no opinion in the matter. Jesus chose you. When He died on the cross for you to save you from your sins and eternal separation from God and to give you new life here and now and everlasting life in the future, Jesus chose you.

This, in and of itself, would certainly be enough far more than we could ever hope or deserve of our own merit. But wait; There's more.

Jesus also appointed you – set you aside as His own, His holy saint-yet-sinner - to do the good works which God the Father created you to do for His glory. And everyone who is baptized into Jesus' death and resurrection, has been gifted by the Holy Spirit to do these good works.

As we hear in the baptismal liturgy, Jesus says, "In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven." (Matthew 5:16) It is for this purpose that we are created, appointed, and given new life: to give glory to God and to teach others to also give glory to God.

So HOW do we do this? The possibilities are endless and as varied as the gifts the Holy Spirit gives. Perhaps you can sing, or cook, or care for others, or clean, or pray. Maybe God has gifted you to be an usher, greeter, lector, Communion assistant, cantor, fellowship host, or to set the altar before and after worship. How has the Holy Spirit gifted you to serve? How are you using those gifts to God's glory and teaching others to also give Him glory?

Let's pray about that. Lord Jesus, you gift us by your Holy Spirit and call each of us to serve you and your Church in some way, as we are able. Help us to see these gifts in ourselves and in others and to use these gifts as you intend. We ask this to your glory and in your holy name we pray. Amen.
