### Introducing NALC Life-to-Life: An Experience in Intentional Discipleship for Congregations

In order to encourage congregations to be more intentional in living out the Great Commission (Matthew 28:16-20), the NALC has created the Life-to-Life discipleship experience. This experience engages congregations in learning how to have discipling conversations that are faithful and natural. Discipleship, however, is more than simply learning techniques or offering conversation starters. Though we can teach someone how to proclaim the Good News of Jesus, we cannot implant the desire to share the Gospel with others. Only the Holy Spirit can do that. For this reason, Life-to-Life is an experience rather than a program or course. Yes, it will engage the mind in sound learning, but the ultimate goal is to change hearts and implant a deep desire to live out the Great Commission in our personal and congregational lives. As such, Life-to-Life will focus on three essential areas.

- 1. One with God We make disciples when we *are* disciples. In the Great Commission Jesus sends His disciples to make disciples. We cannot convince others of the importance of following Jesus, if we are not doing so ourselves. Each participant will be asked to devote time every day to prayer, meditation, reflection on God's Word, and honest evaluation of personal discipleship.
- **2. One with another -** Proverbs 27:17 states, "As iron sharpens iron, so one person sharpens another." (NIV)

At the heart of Life-to-Life is learning how to engage others in faith conversations. Participants will have opportunities to practice what they learn with each other.

**3. One Body in Christ Jesus -** Jesus prayed, "I do not ask for these only, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, that they may all be one... so that the world may believe that you have sent me." (John 17:20-23) Participants will gather weekly for learning, prayer, and mutual support.

#### Who is this resource for?

Life-to-Life is both for everyone, and not for everyone. Jesus calls us to follow Him as His disciples and gives us a commission to make disciples. This call and commission is for all followers of Christ by virtue of their baptism. Yet, the Holy Scriptures remind us that not everyone whom Jesus called responded by following. One was unwilling to part with his possessions (Matthew 19:20-21). Others had family obligations that held a higher priority (Mathew 8:19-22). Still others just felt that the teachings of Jesus were too hard to follow (John 6:60 & 66). The real question of discipleship is not, "Who is called?" but rather, "Who will follow?" Life-to-Life is a call to fulfill our baptismal vocation to be and to make disciples. This call is extended to all but can only be answered by those who, like those early disciples, put following Jesus as their highest priority. It will require a high commitment to spend time in prayer, study, personal reflection, and encouragement of others. The invitation to take part in this discipleship journey is extended to all, but it is intended only for those who are willing to take seriously Jesus' call to follow.
